Teamwork Wins LEGO ® Club is based on the LEGO® Therapy model developed by Dr. Dan LeGoff.

Our LEGO® Club is a peer-directed, play-therapy model designed for children with high functioning autism, Asperger's, and other socially related difficulties to learn and apply social and communication skills

Ages 5-7

Two Teamwork Wins autism specialists facilitate small groups using LEGOs®, Knex® and Widgets®. Children learn to connect with peers using a highly preferred medium in a safe and supportive atmosphere.

Ages 8-15

This group uses LEGOS®, Knex®, and Bionicles® to go beyond traditional LEGO® therapy. Participants build communication skills while working with certified peer mentors, who range in age from 10- to 21-years. At the same time, the peer mentors offer guidance and practice on how to fit in with other kids their age while in a relaxed and safe atmosphere.
